## **Facts About Asteroids**



**Basic Information About Asteroids** 

- 1. Asteroids shown are Vesta (upper left), Ida and its moon Dactyl (upper right), Eros (lower left), and Gaspra (lower right). These images are not shown to scale.
- 2. Asteroids are relatively small, inactive, rocky bodies orbiting the Sun.
- 3. Most asteroids orbit the Sun between the orbits of Mars and Jupiter.
- 4. The largest asteroid is Ceres, 590 miles in diameter.
- 5. Some asteroids have orbits that cross the Earth's orbit and therefore have the potential to hit Earth sometime in the future. The probability of this happening is extremely small though.
- 6. This diagram shows the ten largest asteroids compared in size to the Earth's moon.
